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Children in Crossfire

Tanzania's National Multisectoral ECD Programme (NMECDP)

 Tanzania launched its first 5-Yr National Multisectoral ECD Programme 2021/26

 Flagship programme for Tanzania aiming to ensure all young children develop to their full potential

 [Mainstream] Media identified as a key communication strategy to raise awareness + generate accountability ⇒ at all levels for access + quality ECD



Media for ECD







- Tanzanians rely on media as main source of news / information - 45% rely on radio (Media Council of Tanzania)
- Media monitoring baseline study reported no Focused ECD reporting in Tanzanian media (CiC, 2019)
- Union of Tanzania Press Clubs (UTPC) umbrella body for regional press clubs (local journalists) located in all 26 mainland regions + Zanzibar
- UTPC and Children in Crossfire partnership since 2019 to support quality media reporting of ECD.
 - Journalists trained as ECD champions in all 26 mainland regions
 - >1,000 stories on ECD across all 26 mainland regions 2019-2021
 - Stories span all ECD Components (nurturing care, nutrition, health, early learning, security + safety)
 - Broadcast, Print, Digital Media [36% Radio 34% Newsprint 25%
 Digital 5% TV] [70% National 30% Community Media]
- Since 2022, UTPC/CiC partnership pivoted to raise awareness
 + generate accountability for NMECDP implementation
- Emphasis to amplify local voices in ECD demand + supply





Nurturing ECD Journalism







- Pool of ECD champion journalists in all 26 regions (Performance MoU, basic stipend)
- Training + continuous Mentorship
 - Science of ECD Training
 - Mentored by [holistic] ECD professionals
 - Mentored by media practitioners on effective
 + responsible journalism
 - 1/4-ly 'Bang' on ECD domain
- Journalists uniquely
 placed to support
 NMECDP implementation
 @ Sub-national + National











ECD Journalism Coverage

Number of stories published/aired per media outlet


- All 26 regions
 All ECD components
- 801 stories (Jan-Dec 2022)
- All formats of Mainstream Media
- Developed Tool for Quality Assessment (Earned Media Value ⇒ Policy delivery)
- 55% met high quality threshold (Yr 2022)

Community Radio Amplifying Local Voices







- Journalists also support live Community Radio shows bringing together ECD experts, government officials, and citizens, with active listener engagement.
- Community-based radio amplifies local voices

 increases public awareness / wider
 accountability of ECD policy + practice
 (demand + supply)
- 101 live community radio shows in Yr-1 (25/26 regions) (>2,150 sms + 600 live phonecalls)
