 - Serve as a data base and technical interface with continental and global stakeholders


ECD Starts with Good Nutrition

MALNUTRITION is a global problem


1.9 BILLION adults are overweight or obese


2 BILLION people suffer from some form of micronutrient deficiency

- **143 countries** (where there is data) experience **at least one form of malnutrition** at high levels
- 124 countries experience high levels of at least two forms of malnutrition
- Of the 124 countries, **37 experience high levels of all three forms of malnutrition**, mainly in Africa








AUDA-NEPAD Private Sector Framework

The overall objective of this guideline is to contribute to the improvement of food and nutrition security situation in Sub-Sahara Africa by providing guidelines for private sector engagement and strengthening networks for increasing both direct nutrition and nutrition sensitive investments. E.g. for ECD.

- It is intended that this guideline will help to:
- Enable more private sector engagement especially for Better Maternal and Child Nutrition in Africa.
- Motivate the private sector to adopt nutrition sensitive investments as part of the African Union (AU) strategic framework for better nutrition.
- Strengthen the food and nutrition coalitions, especially the School Meals Coalition to mainstream nutrition sensitive investment and engagement of private sector.




